## Proposed objectives

- To establish a Europe-wide Certifying Organisation (AO)
- To ensure the optimal implementation of the European educational standards as represented by the Fitness occupations
- To quality assure training provision across the fitness and outdoor sector in Europe



## Definition

*An organisation that designs, develops, supports the delivery of and awards **qualifications**.*

*Attaining these qualifications involves the achievement of **learning outcomes** (knowledge, skills and/or competences (range/autonomy)) by an individual following an **assessment** and **quality assurance** process that is valued by employers, learners or stakeholders.*

(adapted from the UK Federation of Awarding Bodies)

## How will the CO work

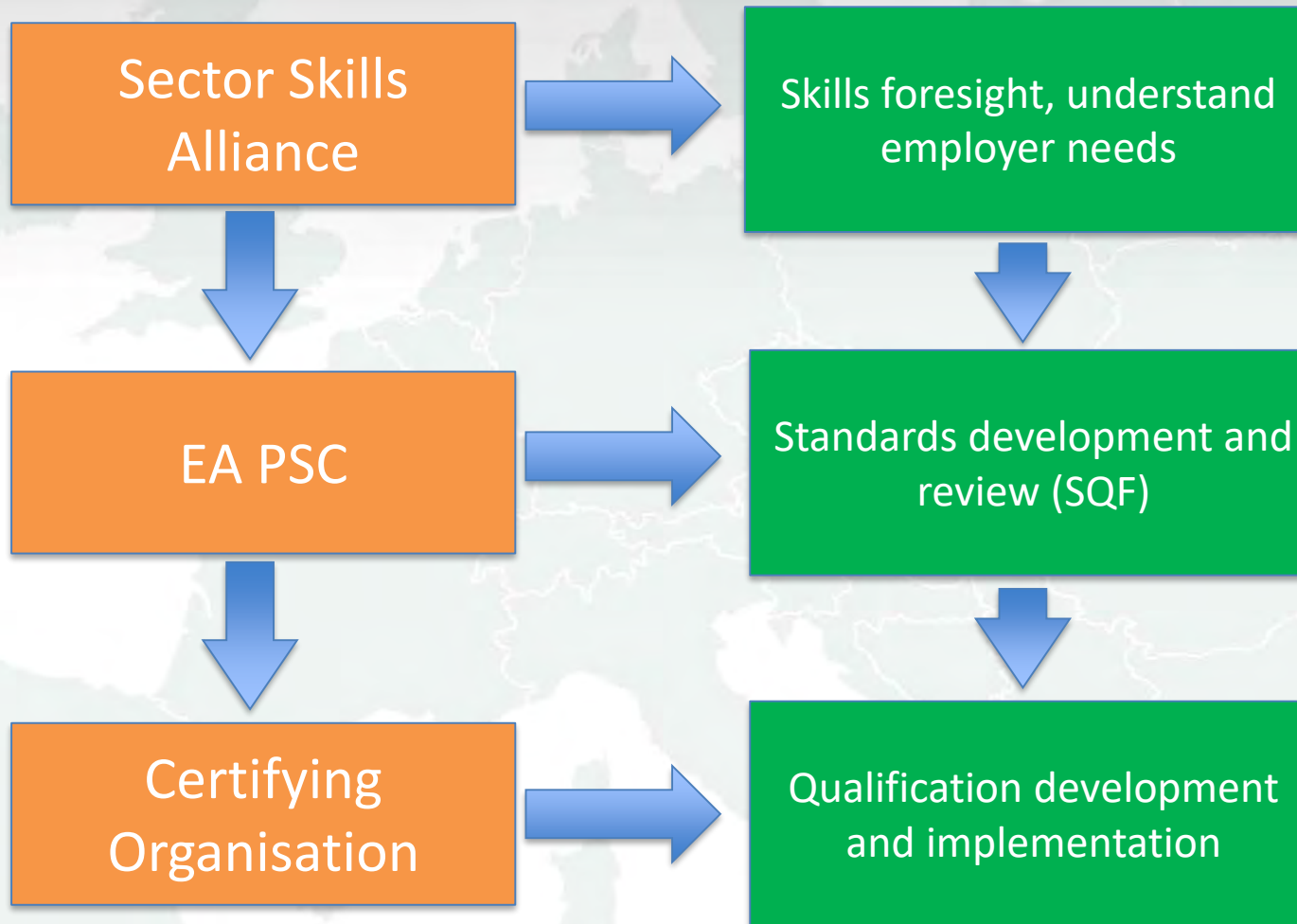
- a Business Unit within EuropeActive - own governance structure linked to wider EA governance

Business unit definition:

*A logical element or segment of a company representing a specific business function or functional area, with a definite place on the organisational chart and under the domain of a manager.*

*A unit within the overall corporate identity which is distinguishable from other business because it serves a defined external market*
